Many of you have heard on the news today about the tragedy that has occurred in the Petionville neighborhood of Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

A school building filled with more than 500 students and teachers has collapsed, leaving many children dead, injured or in shock. The La Promesse School is only a few miles from our Mercy & Sharing hospital/clinic. Please know that we have put the full weight of our resources and infrastructure toward helping those in need. Our Mercy & Sharing doctors are right now on the scene giving medical aid and relief to the injured and dying. Making this situation even worse is the fact that the government-run hospital in Port-au-Prince is on strike and is refusing to treat the victims. Our small hospital/clinic has already had many victims of this awful disaster come in looking for medical treatment and emotional support.

Please keep the parents, children, teachers and loved ones of those affected, in your thoughts and prayers. Many of the Mercy & Sharing staff are friends of the parents who sent their children to school this morning, only to stand beside them all day today, waiting to see if their children survived.

The next few days, as the rubble is cleared away, will be a very difficult time for all of Haiti – this is a huge tragedy...
